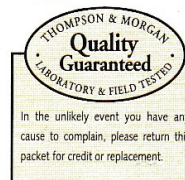
Meaty, delicious fruits, which can easily attain weights over 227g (1/2lb) if trusses are trimmed. Early to set and ripen when grown under glass. Excellent for exhibition and competitions - you could grow a record breaker!

- **Flavour guide:** Meaty and tasty, ideal for slicing
- **Huge fruits,** trim to allow 3 or 4 fruits to ripen per truss
- **Indeterminate habit** requires support and sideshooting
- **Sow February to April,** harvest July to October
- **Best grown in the greenhouse,** or a sunny spot outside

SOWING INSTRUCTIONS Sow seeds 6mm (1/4in) deep in pots or trays of good, free-draining, damp, seed compost and cover with a sprinkling of vermiculite or compost. Place containers in a propagator, or seal in a polythene bag, at a temperature of 18–21C (65–70F) until after germination, which takes 7–10 days.

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS Transplant seedlings, when large enough to handle, into 7.5cm (3in) pots. Plant in the greenhouse in individual large pots, or 3 plants per growbag when 20cm (8in) high. Can be planted outdoors, 45cm (18in) apart once all frost risk has passed. Plants require sideshooting and support for the best yields. Water and feed plants regularly with a high potash feed once the first truss has set.

Tomatoes are packed with antioxidants and high in Vitamin A and C, and lycopene, all helping to stimulate your body's immune system. One single slice of this giant tomato fills a sandwich.

Storing seed in a cool, frost-free area, out of direct sunlight, in an airtight container.
