Dependable, traditional favourite producing medium size fruits until autumn frost.
Suitable for glasshouse and outdoor cultivation, indeterminate, provide support.
Prefers fertile soil or growing bags.

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS

Sow Sow indoors, January to March, for greenhouse crops. March to April, for outdoor crops.

In pots of seed compost. Sow thinly, cover with a fine layer of compost. Firm gently and keep moist. Keep at approx. 15-20°C (60-68°F). Seedlings appear 7-14 days.

Care When plants reach a height of 15cm (6in) transplant to individual pots. Keep at approx. 15°C (60°F).

For greenhouse crops: Transplant to growing position in growing bags or large pots in the greenhouse in April to May.

For outdoor crops: Stand outside for a few days late May (avoid frosts). Transplant to a sunny spot outside, spacing 45cm (18in) apart or in large pots or growing bags. Pinch out side shoots regularly and growing tips once 4-6 trusses have set. Provide support and tie up where necessary. Keep moist and weed free.

Harvest June to October, outdoor crops from August.

Tip Apply a liquid feed every 2-3 weeks when first trusses have set.

Please open carefully, small seeds inside.
