### GROWING INSTRUCTIONS

**Sow** Sow indoors, January to March, for greenhouse crops. March to April, for outdoor crops.  
In pots or trays of seed compost. Sow thinly, cover with a fine layer of compost. Firm gently and keep moist. Keep at approx. 15-20°C (60-68°F). Seedlings appear 7-14 days.

**Care** When plants reach a height of 15cm (6in) transplant to individual pots. Keep at approx. 15°C (60°F).  
**For greenhouse crops:** Transplant to growing position in growing bags or large pots in the greenhouse from April to May.  
**For outdoor crops:** Stand outside for a few days late May (avoid frosts). Transplant to a sunny spot outside, spacing 45cm (18in) apart or in large pots or growing bags. Pinch out side shoots regularly and growing tips once 4-6 trusses have set. Provide support and tie up where necessary. Keep moist and weed free.

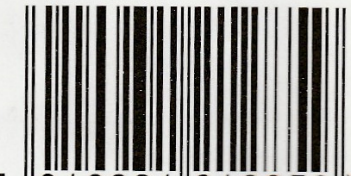
**Harvest** June to October, outdoor crops from August.

**Tip** Apply a liquid feed every 2-3 weeks when first trusses have set.
