TOMATO SWEET BABY

Solanum lycopersicum L. 'Sweet Baby' Common name: Tomato


Outstanding variety producing a very prolific crop of 8-10g (1/30z) small, cherry sized fruits with a delicious sweet taste plus a bit of traditional tomato 'bite'. Trusses hang like bunches of grapes when grown outdoors or under glass as a side shooted cordon.

- Flavour guide: Very sweet, bite-sized fruits
- Easy to grow variety as a cordon (removing side shoots)
- Suitable for indoor and outdoor growing
- Sow April to May
- Prefers well-drained, moist, rich soil in full sun
- Harvest August until first frosts

SOWING INSTRUCTIONS Place seed on the surface of a good, freedraining, damp seed compost and cover with a fine sprinkling of compost or vermiculite. Place in a propagator at a constant temperature of around 18-20C (64-68F) until after germination, which takes 7-10 days.

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS Transplant seedings when large enough to handle into 7.5cm (3in) pots. Plant in final situation when 20cm (8in) high, 45cm (18in) apart. Remove sideshoots regularly.

SERVING SUGGESTION The perfect cherry fruit, ideal for fresh salads.





T&M RECOMMENDS Storing seed in a cool, frost-free area, out of direct sunlight, in an airtight container.
