

## TOMATO TUMBLING TIGER F1 HYBRID

Solanum lycopersicum L'Tumbling Tiger' F1 Hybrid Common name: Tomato

British breeding. Compact habit when grown in a 20cm (8in) pot on the windowsill or has a 'gentle trailing' habit if planted in a 35cm (14in) basket or container. Prolific crop of striped, plum shaped fruits of a juicy flavour.

- Flavour guide: Sweet and juicy
- Decorative striped fruits
- Early crops in baskets and containers
- Sow indoors: January to April
- No support or sideshooting required
- Harvest July to October

SOWING INSTRUCTIONS Sow seeds 6mm (1/4 in) deep in pots or trays of good, free-draining, damp, seed compost and cover with a sprinkling of vermiculite or compost. Place containers in a propagator, or seal in a polythene bag, at a temperature of 18-21C (65-70F) until after germination. which takes 7-10 days.

FOR INDOOR CROPS Plant finally into tubs, containers or hanging baskets in the greenhouse or conservatory. Water regularly and feed weekly with high potash tomato food once first flowers have set.

FOR OUTDOOR CROPS Acclimatise plants to outdoor conditions for a few days before planting into tubs, containers or hanging baskets. Protect from cold winds until established.
